## Executive Summary

The President's Fiscal Year 2013 Budget Request includes \$28 billion in base funding for the National Guard. These accounts reflect the increased demand on the Army National Guard as an operational force and a force structure designed to train for full spectrum operations. As a result, the Army National Guard Personnel and Operations and Maintenance are funded above Fiscal Year 2012 levels. The request also includes reductions in Army National Guard military construction and procurement within some Army accounts.

The Air National Guard request reflects the Air Force plan for reductions in end-strength and aircraft as well as the return of participation in training to pre-9/11 levels as a result of the decrease in mobilizations to support Overseas Contingency Operations.

This guide provides only a short summary and analysis of the many provisions within the budget request.
